IMMERSION INTO INNER & OUTER NATURE

Crow Collective is an **extended immersion program designed to support youth in deepening their connection with the natural world** and create opportunities for self-discovery as they begin to transition into young adulthood.

During these eight weekends over eight months, youth will be engaged in learning experiences focusing on a range of topics including: naturalist knowledge, backcountry & bushcraft skills, community leadership, wildlife tracking, interpersonal development, natural & cultural heritage, self-awareness practices, and communication skills.

Together we will transverse and engage with the Salish Sea, Cascade mountains, Eastern Washington shrub-steppe, and visit cultural sites. Participants will engage in many of our core practices, such as daily sharing circles, self-discovery activities, solo time, gratitude, community building, games and of course cooking together!
