Summer 2017 delivered the launch of our new flagship training program, Restoring Youth Rites of Passage: Two-Week Leadership Intensive. The fully-enrolled program was deeply catalytic in its first year, and we are on track for a honed 2nd cohort in 2018. Also full, the Adult Wilderness Quest returned with participants, guides and witnesses astoundingly grateful for the richness and transformation of the journey. A new weekend workshop and ensuing monthly community circle exploring dreamwork is nourishing our community of adults into 2018.
